Draft/Carting Clinic - ALL BREEDS WELCOME Saturday - March 18th, 2023

The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Greater Seattle is sponsoring an all-breed draft clinic. We have 3 instructors this year. Meredith Gilbert will be teaching the beginner teams who have not pulled a cart previously. Meredith has been drafting for over 20 years and has earned draft titles on her own dogs in the US and Canada. She has taught dogs of varied stubbornness and attitudes to enjoy drafting with their people at clinics and classes. Phil Chagnon and Lea Doane will be teaching the teams already pulling carts to advance their skills and problem-solve issues (could include but not limited to equipment adjustments/use, handling, pulling skills, roadblocks, test readiness, etc). Phil & Lea have been involved with drafting since the 90's. As well as earning draft titles on their own dogs, they have judged tests, written on the sport, taught clinics, and love to help people discover the amazing bond that is created through true teamwork.

Many breeds and mixed breeds of all different sizes and shapes can learn to pull a cart. Once you learn to draft with your dog then you and your canine partner can share the fun of carting, hauling all sorts of stuff, participating in parades, and even draft tests.

Harnesses; carts and training equipment will be available to use the day of the clinic. Along with your dog *each person is highly encouraged to bring a helper* to assist them as they go through the training process. Your helper will assist you in the actual training exercises. The clinic will focus on a lecture going over the carting basics and hands on training/ practice session with the dogs. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A HELPER available you may not be able to complete some of the hands-on training and practice but can still participate in the lecture and demonstration.

 - With draft harness on, leash will be attached to dog's collar. Please no pinch collars, e-collars, or halti's. While these can be useful training aids, they tend to confuse the dog when learning to draft.
- > Chairs to sit in.
- Favorite training treats and lots of them.
- > Your helper
- > Beginners: A one gallon plastic milk/drink carton full of water for dragging
- > Teams already pulling carts: Harness and cart if you have them
